

Pre-Export Checks (PEC) Certification – GB Certificate FAQs

When does the GB PEC Certificate apply for shipments to the UK regions? USDA/SPI will begin issuing GB PEC Certificates on <u>January 15</u>, 2024.

If a lot destined for the UK was sampled and analyzed prior to January 15, 2024, but the certificate not issued until after January 15, 2024, what cert will be issued? If "United Kingdom" is selected in the country designation a GB certificate will be issued on or after 1/15/24, regardless of the sample and analysis date.

Will issuance within <u>7 days (calendar days) of the truck's bill lading</u> date apply to GB PEC Certificates?

Yes, this requirement applies to GB PEC Certificates as well.

Can you ship a consignment to the UK before the GB PEC launch date of January 15, 2024?

- Any certificates for UK destinations issued prior to January 15, 2024, will be an EU PEC Certificate.
- The UK will continue to allow PEC certificates to be issued prior to January 15, 2024. Any certs issued on or after January 15, 2024, will be on a GB PEC Certificate.

How long are the EU and GB PEC Certificates valid for after issuance? The EU and GB PEC Certificate are valid for 4 months.

Will the GB PEC Certificate need to have a separate PEC Issuance Log (PIL) provided for USDA/SPI upon issuance?

No, the PIL is valid for both the EU and GB PEC Certificates.

How will the PEC Verifications be impacted by introducing the GB PEC Certificates?

- There will be no changes to how the PEC Certificates are selected for the verifications. PEC Certificates are selected at random.
- GB PEC Certificates may be randomly reviewed as part of those selected.

Will the GB aflatoxin tolerance be the same as the EU aflatoxin tolerance of (8ppb B1/10ppb total)?

Yes, the aflatoxin tolerance remains the same for GB PEC Certificates.
