Open Independent Seats:

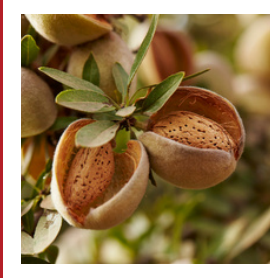
- **Grower #1:** Voting member, 1-year swing
- **Grower #1:** Alternate member, 1-year swing
- **Grower #2:** Voting member, 3-year term
- **Grower #2:** Alternate member, 3-year term
- **Handler #1:** Voting member, 3-year term
*(only 1 year remaining) *This is normally a 3-year seat, but was vacated mid-term; candidate elected for this seat will only serve the remaining 1 year of the term. This position will be up for re-election again in 2026.*
- **Handler #3:** Voting member, 1-year swing
- **Handler #3:** Alternate member, 1-year swing

Open Co-Op Seats:

- **Co-op Handler #1:** Voting member, 3-year term
- **Co-op Handler #1:** Alternate member, 3-year term

Key Dates To Remember:

- **Feb 7** Election Cycle Begins. Candidate Declaration Window Opens.
- **Apr 1** Candidate Declaration Window Closes. Last Day for ABC to receive Letters of Intent and Grower Petitions.
- **Apr 21** Ballots Mailed to Independent Growers & Handlers. Election Voting Begins.
- **May 22** Last Day for ABC to Receive Signed Ballots. Election Voting Ends.
- **May 23** Ballots Counted. Election Cycle Ends.
- **Jun 2** Election Results Announced.
- **Aug 1** New Terms of Office Begin.
